On the basis of documents including affidavits produced by the
Management of your school and after careful consideration of the
recommendations made by District Education Officer (S), Gurdaspur and
Director, Private Aided School, (s), Chandigarh, No Objection Certificate is
hereby issued by the Punjab Government on the following conditions -

1. On the basis of any complaint/inspection in future, if this fact comes
into light that you have applied to the government with wrong
information for obtaining N.O.C. or you are not abiding by the
instructions issued by the govt. from time to time and the written
conditions in your affidavits, the NOC can be withdrawn in such
circumstances.
2. Teaching of Punjabi upto Matric level will be compulsory in your
school and C.B.S.E. will make all the arrangements for Punjabi
Examination. If it is not done, NOC will be withdrawn.
3. After getting affiliation with CBSE, School Management will be
responsible to pay salary & other allowances to the teaching and
non teaching staff at par with government employees. In violation of
the same, NOC will be withdrawn forthwith.
4. Yourself and your school management will make it sure to provide
any type of information, as and when demanded by your District
Education Officer or by any other senior officer of Education
Department and you will extend full cooperation to them.
